What is the Coming Home Project?

The Coming Home Project is a community-based, after-school and summer program that promotes positive self-esteem, good decision-making, and positive peer relationships among youth ages 8-21.

Program Objectives

- To improve participants' capacity to learn and do well in school.
- To reduce the risk of destructive behaviors.
- To increase the youth's understanding of interpersonal relationships.
- To ensure that youth have a safe and nurturing environment to have fun and learn more about themselves and other members of the community.



Activities Offered

Youth participants will receive homework help, community service opportunities, computer activities, discussion groups, outdoor activities, field trips, board games, arts & crafts projects, and more!

Individual Assistance

Youth Workers from the Coming Home Project are able to spend time with youth and their families in addition to the after-school and summer program hours. They will set goals with each child and work with the family and school staff to help them achieve those goals. Staff members have the ability to meet with families in their home, at the child's school, and at various places in the community.

Who can Participate?

The Coming Home Project is free to any youth ages 8 to 21. Youth may join the program at any time. Simply detach and return your completed form if you wish to participate.

Hours and Location

All after-school and summer programming is held at **Trinity Lutheran Church**, 330 South Broadway Street in Green Bay. Program hours are 3:30 - 7:00 pm on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays.
