Sessions will take place from 6:00 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. on Wednesdays and 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Saturdays at Family Services, 300 Crooks Street, Green Bay.

By participating in the training, volunteer advocates learn methods to provide support and follow-up assistance to victims of sexual assault and abuse. Advocates help provide hotline phone coverage, assist in medical and legal advocacy, and serve in other supportive roles. No experience is necessary.
