## 6<sup>th</sup> Annual Suicide Prevention Ride to Support Crisis Center of Family Services

A Suicide Prevention Ride scheduled for August 30 will donate all proceeds to the Crisis Center of Family Services to support the program's suicide prevention efforts.

(**Green Bay, Wis.**) – A 'Suicide Prevention Ride' is scheduled for Sunday, August 30 in the Greater Green Bay area. Registration takes place from 10:30 - 11:30 am at Legends Brewhouse & Eatery, 2840 Shawano Avenue in Green Bay. Breakfast will be available for purchase. The ride is scheduled to leave at 12:00 pm, making stops at Jen's Knaughty Pine Bar & Grill in Pulaski and The Country Club in Abrams.

The final stop will include live music by Fine Line at CZ's Geano Beach Resort, 2060 Sand Bar Way in Little Suamico, beginning at 5:00 pm, along with raffles and door prizes. All proceeds benefit the Crisis Center of Family Services in support of its suicide prevention services in Brown County.

"Nearly everyone I know, myself included, knows someone who has committed suicide. The ride is being held to bring awareness to the issue and support prevention efforts in the community," says event organizer Jeanne Parrett. "Proceeds from this event will help the Crisis Center continue its important work to help others recognize the signs and get help before it's too late."
