

# Open Door Youth Services

*Grant Program for Runaway Youth Who Have Experienced Sexual Assault or Abuse*

Open Door Youth Services, a program of Family Services of Northeast Wisconsin, now offers specialized case management and advocacy services for runaway or 'throwaway' youth who have experienced sexual assault or abuse.

Any youth who meets the following requirements is eligible for services:

- Must be between the ages of 13 and 24
- Are on the run, at risk of running away, or are currently homeless
- Have experienced sexual assault, abuse or harassment
- Are a resident of Brown or Door County



Services include case management, individual and/or family counseling, and legal advocacy for as long as it is needed. All services are free and confidential.
