

When I walked through the doors of Family Services nearly 39 years ago, I could never have imagined the incredible journey ahead. What began as the first step in my professional career quickly became a lifelong calling. It has been the honor of a lifetime to grow alongside this organization, witness its profound impact, and contribute to a mission that matters so deeply.

Throughout the years, I've watched Family Services evolve and respond to our community's changing needs, always striving to create brighter futures for those we serve. This remarkable growth would not have been possible without your support. Together, we've built a legacy of trust, compassion, and resilience, ensuring families and individuals have critical support when they need it most.

I am particularly proud of how Family Services has placed mental health at the heart of our mission. The reduction in stigma and the growing number of people seeking help is one of the most remarkable advancements I've seen in my career. Our team has fully embraced this evolution, integrating mental health support into everything we do, from home visits and therapy to community-based care.

That said, we are facing some significant challenges. Recent federal funding cuts have created a deficit of over \$800,000, directly impacting our victim services programs. For five decades, our Sexual Assault Center has been by the side of survivors 24/7, ensuring no one has to face an evidentiary exam, a police report, or the long road to healing alone. We must ensure this support continues.

In the midst of these challenges, my hope remains strong because of the support our community continues to show. Every day, I see the impact you make. Together, as donors, volunteers, community partners, and staff, we will continue to protect, heal, and care for Northeast Wisconsin.

Thank you for believing in our mission. Thank you for walking beside us. And thank you for allowing me to be a part of this remarkable journey. As I transition from CEO and President to community supporter, I leave knowing that Family Services will continue to thrive, innovate, and make an even greater impact in the years to come.

A LETTER FROM **CLAIRE**, A GRATEFUL MOM

Dear Family Services,

Because of you, families like Claire's can thrive.

When I was first referred to your Healthy Families program, I felt overwhelmed and fearful. I was worried about being judged and uncertain about how to give my son, Carson, the bright future he deserved. I didn't know what to expect or if I could ever feel truly confident as a mom.

Then Andrea, our Family Support Specialist, walked into our lives, and everything started to change.

Andrea brought kindness, compassion, and genuine respect. She never judged me. Instead, she stood by me, offering guidance and encouragement, helping me feel confident as a parent. She taught me about developmental milestones and how to best support Carson's growth, making sure he had every opportunity to thrive.

But Andrea did more than just share parenting tips. She taught me how to be present, play, and truly connect with my son. Those small moments playing together, laughing, and simply being present built a bond that has become the foundation of our family's future.

When I lost my job, Andrea was there to help me find critical resources to keep our family stable. She connected us with support for food, housing, and other essentials, giving me the stability and confidence I needed to keep moving forward.

Today, Carson is a curious, confident, and healthy little boy. He is full of life and love, and I see every day how those small, connected moments have shaped who he is becoming.

I can truly say that Andrea didn't just help me become a better mom, she became part of our family.

Thank you, Andrea, and thank you, Healthy Families. You've changed our lives, and I'll always be grateful.

When Matthew called 988, he was at his
breaking point. A devastating breakup left
him feeling alone, overwhelmed, and
convinced he had no reason to keep
going. In that moment, reaching out to
988 was a final act of hope, even when
he felt he had none left.

The 988 Lifeline Counselor gave him

The 988 Lifeline Counselor gave him the space to talk through his pain, reminding him that asking for help took real courage. Matthew admitted he wanted support but doubted he could access the professional care he needed. Because you make services like 988 and the Crisis Center possible, that call didn't end in tragedy. The Lifeline Counselor connected him to the Crisis Center, where local staff helped him problem solve the barriers he was experiencing to find the mental health and substance use treatment he needed to begin his journey toward recovery.

Today, Matthew continues to reach out when he needs support. And because of you, he knows he's never alone.
